

# STARK COUNTY 2022 “PEE-WEE” SHOW

Horse- Monday, August 1<sup>st</sup> @ 9:00am

Beef- Sunday, July 31<sup>st</sup> @ 10:00am

Poultry & Rabbits- Friday, July 29<sup>th</sup> @ 1:00pm

Swine- Friday, July 29<sup>th</sup> @ 9:00am

Sheep/Goat- Saturday July 30<sup>th</sup> @ 1:00pm

**WHAT:** Stark County Junior Fair Board welcomes both 4-H and non-4H youth to participate in a livestock exhibition. This is an introductory livestock show to youth who are not under 4-H age to show at county fair. The animal is not judged on conformation or breed. While in show ring, the participant will exhibit their animal in a showmanship manner according to the selected judge’s criteria (stand animal, side view animal, and parade animal).

**AGE LIMIT:** 3 to 8 years old as of the day of the show and not eligible for the 4-H/Junior Show

**REQUIREMENTS:** • Exhibitor must have a paid entry fee, signed waiver, and registration form • Exhibitor will provide the animal for the exhibition (does not need to own/lease their animal, but have general knowledge of livestock exhibition- may borrow animal but must meet prior registration & waiver requirements) • Entry FEE of \$5 per livestock class exhibition • Pre-registration is preferred but ENTRIES WILL BE TAKEN UP TO 9:00 AM ON THE DAY OF THE SHOW • Show Placing is determined off individual’s ability to exhibit livestock (showmanship) • All breeds will be shown together in the identified classes (one class of all exhibitors, i.e. barrows with gilts, heifers with steers, etc.) • All animals exhibited must comply with General Health Regulations of the Stark County Jr Fair • Animals will be exhibited at livestock Superintendent’s decision for time of show • All horse, beef, and swine animals to be exhibited must be stalled by 8am day of show; all Sheep/Goat, Rabbits, and Poultry animals to be exhibited must be stalled by 1pm day of show; all exhibitors will provide their own bedding • Animals released only by the permission of the livestock superintendent • No premiums will be paid to exhibitors in the Pee-Wee Show.
